





Our University Partner

University of Chester

University Centre St Helens is an approved academic partner of University of Chester. We have a very strong relationship with the university and it is our largest university partner. Students studying on a University of Chester validated degree will have access to a wide range of resources.



Library and Resources

You will be able to access a variety of online resources including Moodle, the university's virtual learning environment, standard access to the library collections at any university library in Chester, Warrington and Shrewsbury and access to e-journals and ebooks (subject to licensing terms) and Office 365.

Careers and Employability

A range of careers information resources is available through Portal, which can be accessed by both students and academic and personal tutoring staff. These resources are identical to those used by Careers and Employability staff working with students at University of Chester.

Student Support and Development

Students registered for University of Chester degrees but based at University Centre St Helens can access all of the online self-help resources available on the Student Support and Development Portal web pages.

Chester Students' Union

Chester Students' Union (CSU) is an independent charitable organisation, which aims to ensure that students are supported and that student views and opinions are voiced at all university meetings.

Students studying at University Centre St Helens are still a very valued member of the Union and CSU will help with any support you may need as a University of Chester student.



Financial Support and Student Support

We understand that making the decision to study at degree level is a big commitment, but it is important to remember that there is a lot of information and additional support available.

Tuition Fees

All eligible, full-time and part-time undergraduate students are able to apply for a tuition fee loan to cover the cost of their course fees. You will not pay back any of your course fees until your income is over £27,295 a year.


Degrees in the Heart of St Helens


Located in the heart of a bustling town centre, we are surrounded by a range of shops, cafés, restaurants and fantastic public transport and road networks.

How to Apply

Applying

Applications to study Game Art at University Centre St Helens are made through UCAS (Universities and Colleges Admissions Service) via **ucas.com**.

The institution code for University Centre St Helens is: **S51**

What Happens Next

Your application form will go to our Admissions Team. Each application is treated on its own merit, and we take the time to carefully consider each individual, taking into account a wide range of educational and professional backgrounds, to reach an informed decision.

You will then be invited to attend an interview in addition to submiting a portfolio of work.

UCAS Extra And Clearing

If you do not receive offers from your five chosen universities, you could get another chance to join us through the UCAS Extra scheme from February, and Clearing in August.

International Applicants

If you are a non-EU/EEA/Swiss national, you may need to apply for a Tier 4 visa in order to enter and study in the UK. However, please note that University Centre St Helens does not hold a Tier 4 Sponsor Licence to support student visa applications.
